

# Easy Knitting Projects

## Hat and Scarf

*These are worked entirely in K2, P2 ribbing. But because it is difficult to measure gauge on ribbing, the gauge is given in stock st. So you will make a stock st swatch to check your gauge. We've shown the set in off white, but you can of course make it any color you like.*

### Size:

One size fits most adults

### Materials:

Worsted weight yarn, 14 oz (980 yds) off white, or color of your choice

Size 9, 14" straight knitting needles, or size required for gauge

Size 16 tapestry needle

### Gauge:

9 sts = 2" in stock st

## Instructions

### Hat

Cast on 108 sts loosely.

**Row 1:** K1, P2, \* K2, P2; rep from \* across row, ending K1.

**Row 2:** P1, K2, \* P2, K2; rep from \* across row, ending K1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until Hat measures 11" from cast-on edge.

### Crown:

**Row 1:** K1, P2 tog; \* K2 tog; P2 tog; rep from \* across row, ending K1: 55 sts.

**Row 2:** P1, \* K2 tog; rep from \* across row: 28 sts.

**Row 3:** \* K2 tog; rep from \* across row: 14 sts.

**Row 4:** \* K2 tog; rep from \* across row.

Cut yarn leaving an 18" end for sewing.

Thread end into yarn needle; thread through sts on needle twice, removing needle as you thread. Pull yarn end tight. With right side facing you, weave seam from crown to cast-on edge.

Weave in all loose ends.

Turn cast-on edge up to form cuff.

## Scarf

Cast on 52 sts loosely.

**Row 1:** P1, K2, \* P2, K2; rep from \* across row, ending P1.

**Row 2:** K1, P2, \* K2, P2; rep from \* across row, ending K1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until scarf measures 72" long.

Bind off loosely in pattern (knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts).

Weave in all loose ends.
